



## Russian Quota Scholarship Program for NArFU International Students

Northern (Arctic) Federal University named after M.V. Lomonosov (Arkhangelsk, Russia) is pleased to invite foreign citizens and compatriots living abroad to participate in the competition to attend NArFU according to RF Government Regulation № 891 dated October 8, 2013.

Quota Programme **covers tuition fee for selected educational program at NArFU in the form of scholarships**. Foreign citizens are provided with equal rights with Russian students throughout the learning period.

Prospective students are welcome to take [undergraduate](#), [graduate](#) and [postgraduate](#) degree program. Foreign citizens who don't have a good enough command of Russian language are given an additional year to study the Russian language at the preparatory department for international students of NArFU.

Applicants for admission under Quota Programme should fill in the application form on the NArFU website and provide the NArFU International Office with all required documents:

- Scanned documents – **until July 1, 2014** at [international@narfu.ru](mailto:international@narfu.ru);
- Original documents – **until July 10, 2014** at 163002, Russia, Arkhangelsk, 17 Naberezhnaya Severnoy Dviny, NArFU International Office (1326 A)

### List of required documents:

- Filled-in application form with an attached color photograph;
- Copies of passport pages foreign citizen will use when crossing the border of the Russian Federation, valid for at least 18 months from the begin date of the student entry visa (clearly readable pages containing information necessary for the invitation);
- Copy of the document confirming education with the list of taken subjects and grades (marks);
- Copy of medical certificate confirming absence of contraindications for study in the Russian Federation issued by an official authority of the candidate's country of residence
- Copy of medical certificate of negative HIV and AIDS test results issued by an official authority of the candidate's country of residence;
- Copy of birth certificate (if present);
- Motivation letter with the reasons why the applicant would like to study in Russia, in the Northern (Arctic) Federal University (Arkhangelsk) (*in English or Russian*)
- Copies of documents (diplomas, certificates, etc. of winners of international and national (city and other) academic competitions);
- \*CV (resume) (for applicants for graduate degree programs- *in English or Russian*);
- \*Abstract in Russian and / or English language (for applicants for postgraduate degree programs);
- \*List of publications issued in the Harvard style (for applicants for postgraduate degree programs).

NB! All documents should be translated to the Russian language and notarized!
