## Notes

1. Lakehead University International offers a free airport pick-up service for all new exchange students.
2. Lakehead University requires all international and exchange students to be registered in the University Health Insurance Plan (UHIP) at a rate of approximately \$51 per month (\$204 per semester).
3. All new exchange students will receive a Welcome Package containing information pertinent to their arrival (Orientation, Accommodations, UHIP, and more).
