Climate change effects on arctic landscapes: integrating responses across terrestrial and aquatic ecosystems

The course will be held in **Abisko** in northern Sweden between **June 21 to June 26, 2015**. The course is open for students from the four participating universities. Student expenses, such as travel and accommodation, will be covered by the Barents summer school program.

Hosting University is Umeå University, Sweden. The course is managed by the Climate Impacts Research Centre (CIRC) at the department of Ecology and Environmental Science and the Arctic Centre at Umeå University (ARCUM).

Barents Summer School is a collaboration between the universities of Umeå, Oulu, Tromsø and Archangelsk. The second Barents Summer School will be held summer 2015 in Abisko, Sweden, focusing on climate change effects on the arctic landscape.
